

EVERGLADES Mitigation Bank

The Everglades Mitigation Bank (EMB) is a wetland restoration project, owned and operated by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) that is returning more than 13,500 acres of wetlands to their natural condition. The project is located in southern Miami-Dade County and services all of Miami- Dade and Broward counties and portions of Palm Beach County.

The EMB's size and unique location have contributed to a seamless wildlife corridor between two national parks (Biscayne and Everglades National Parks). It is home to 46 threatened, endangered and listed species. These environmentally sensitive lands are also a key component to the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Program (CERP).

The commitment of this site to the mitigation bank process satisfies the goals of local, regional, state, and national agencies and at the same time allows private individuals and developers to participate in the restoration of one of Florida's greatest environmental treasures when offsetting unavoidable wetland impacts with EMB credits.
